Sharp Corporation has announced the release of the new Ultra-Bright, High-Resolution, High-End DLP® Projector, the Sharp XG-PH70X, specifically designed as a large venue projector for business and education.

Sharp's new top of the range projector truly highlights the big picture thanks to the impressive 500 inch maximum screen size, outstanding 5200 ANSI lumens brightness and cutting-edge DLP™ technology.

When it comes to high level performance, the XG-PH70X is in a class of its own boasting a long-life DMD™ Panel combined with Sharp's new high image quality lens with 1.2 powered zoom/focus. This is backed up by inbuilt state-of-the-art features like the Computer & Video Integrated Composer II System which offers individual colour adjustment, detection of 24 frame/sec. format, reduction of picture blur and providing high-quality clear pictures.

Another innovative XG-PH70X feature is the Sharp Unique Network System; enabling web browser control with remote access and management of the projector via inbuilt firmware. Further network control options are available by downloading and installing Sharp Display Manager onto the main computer from the Sharp Global website.

Designed for presentation convenience, the XG-PH70X boasts digital keystone correction, multiple input and output terminals, low fan noise, wireless remote control with mouse control and presentation support tools such as break timer, enlarge, freeze and black screen. The flexible install system includes powered vertical/horizontal lens shift control and six optional interchangeable lenses for achieving optimum results in a variety of projection conditions, i.e. room size and projection distance.

Other important features include DTV/HDTV compatibility, simple video wall, stack setting function, customisable Gamma correction, high quality video circuits, key lock function and image capture.

The Sharp XG-PH70X is priced at RRP \$8499 with a standard lens included.
