



Sharp's new Notevision projector range adds BrilliantColour™ to the screen

Sharp Corporation of Australia has announced the release of two new Notevision projectors, the PG-F312X and PG-F212X, which have combined true XGA with BrilliantColour™ technology and six-segment colour wheel to dramatically improve onscreen colour reproduction.

As well as producing more brilliant and vibrant colours, these projectors have the ability to project high-resolution images up to UXGA (1600 x 1200) and SXGA+ (1400 x 1050) compatible in Intelligent Compression System. Quality presentation is assured by 2300 ANSI lumens high image brightness in PGF212X and stunning 3000 ANSI lumens in PGF312X for excellent performance even in a bright classroom or conference room environment.

User comfort is a focus of Sharp's new range boasting a full remote control for presentation assist functions including page up/down, GUI pointer, spotlight and optionally computer mouse control. It features the convenience of direct power off, auto restart and up to 20 degrees keystone correction for ease of set up and installation. The exhaust system is located at the front of the projector to help minimise any viewer disturbance from fan noise or airflow.

Sharp new PGF series design is based on advanced DLP® technology, that delivers uniform colour reproduction capabilities and high quality pictures for a longer period of time. Maintenance issues are effectively minimised thanks to the projector's DLP® sealed system and filter-free lamp construction. New lamp design with its excellent dust resistance, easily replaceable by user and long lifespan up to 4,000 hours, contributes to projector low maintenance cost and its extended use.

Sharp has ensured optimum connectivity to external equipment with a wide range of input terminals on both models. Both models offer complete digital projection using the inbuilt DLP® system and DVI terminal (compatible with HDCP). Other terminals include computer/component (mini D-sub 15 pin), S-Video (mini DIN 4 pin), video (RCA), audio, USB (Type B) and RS-232C.
